Installation

Extract all files from the purchased zip file. This should give you a single directory entitled "pro-business#" (replace the # with whatever Pro Business theme version you purchased) with the entire theme inside. Upload this entire theme folder to your installed WordPress theme directory. Once it has completed your new theme should be available and visible in the admin section of your WordPress install, so that you may now select and activate your new theme.

Sidebar

The sidebar is persistent, meaning it shows on nearly every single page type and it is fully widget ready right out of the box. The video box seen in the demo is created using a widget for WordPress and is not included in the theme purchase.

Company Profile Template

The page template for Company Profile is simply a styled page that will show your company name, date your company was established, what location your company is based out of, and main company email. These are blank by default and can be filled in using Custom Fields on the page.

Custom Field keywords are as follows:


company_name = your company name

company_established = the date your company was established

company_based = where your company is based out of (i.e. city,state)

company_email = your main company email

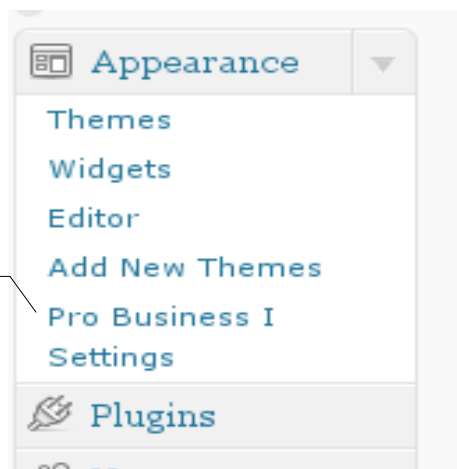

This is how I created the information for the demo theme on my site. Once that is complete, click update or publish page and you are done.

Custom Homepage Categories

You are able to choose what categories go where on your home page and even how many articles show up for each category. The wonderful thing about this is unlike most premium themes now days you do not need to edit any code to change these settings. All this is now available from your WordPress installation administration panel for this theme. Once you are logged in as Administrator simply go to Appearance in the menu, click it to open the menu, inside here you will now see a menu option called Pro Business I Settings. Click on Pro Business I Settings in the menu to get your category options panel available to you.

Once you click on the menu item you will see the new administration page for your theme where you can now customize your categories which will look like the image below.

Homepage Category Settings

Choose Category(Top Main)
Select the categories that should appear on the Index page section 1 or top main section

Choose Category(Bottom Left)
Select the categories that should appear on the Index page section 2 or bottom left

Choose Category(Bottom Right)
Select the category that should appear on the Index page section 3 or bottom right

Top Category
How many excerpts should show for this category? (top main section)

Bottom Left Category
How many excerpts should show for this category? (bottom left section)

Bottom Right Category
How many excerpts should show for this category? (bottom right section)

Note: By default the theme is setup to show category 1 and 3 articles per category on each section. If you reset the form it will go back to default.

Logo

The logo can easily be changed simply by modifying the logo image file in the theme image directory. In the main theme directory is a directory called images. Inside the images directory is a logo image. It will be either logo.png, logo.gif, or logo.jpg but there will only be one logo image file. If your theme came with the logo base file it will be a logo.psd file and should be opened only with Adobe Photoshop by someone experienced to work with graphics.

Slideshow

The featured section is produced on the demo site with the use of a slideshow plugin. The code is easily marked in the index.php file of the theme so that you may insert your own slideshow of choice there.
